

Key stage 2 comparative report

This information allows you to compare your child's performance at the end of key stage 2 with the attainment of other year 6 pupils in our school and across England. This data was initially published in July 2025 and is due to be updated in December 2025. Due to low cohort numbers of below 10 pupils the % of children in school achieving the expected standard has been suppressed, in line with guidance. This is due to the potential for individual children's scores to be identified due to the high percentage value each pupil represents.

The expected standard in writing is a teacher assessment of 'working at the expected standard' or 'working at greater depth'.
