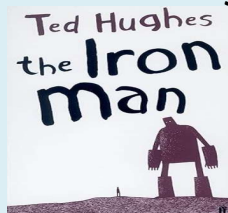




## English

This approach will allow us to analyse the text closely, deepening our understanding of the story and enabling us to answer questions with insight and depth.



## Maths

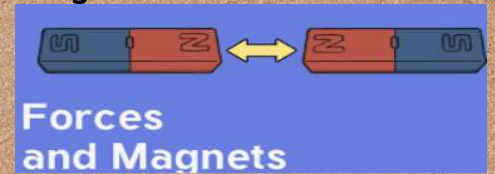
We will be learning:

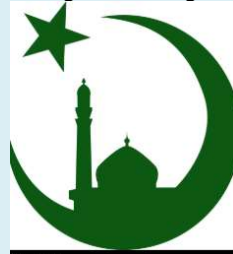
## Design and Technology

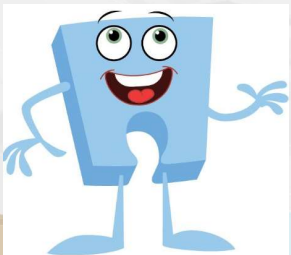
## Music
