As writers we will focus on writing based on the book *Cogheart* by Peter Bunzl.

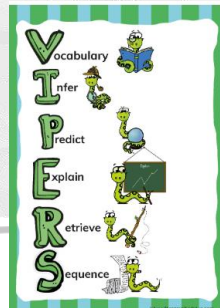


* We will be analysing the way in which characters are described and developed throughout the book.

In our topic this term, Living things and their habitats, we will be considering the question

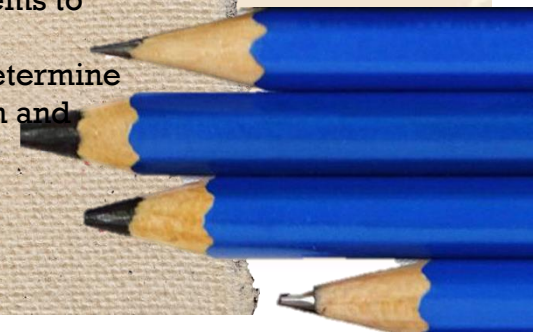
'Do all living things have the same life cycle?'

History

We are historians!

Our topic this term is the Bronze Age to Iron Age. We will be building on our historical knowledge, discovering how people used to live, what they ate, the tools they used during this period in time. We will also understand how and why changes occurred between the ages.



RE

Religious Education

We begin our RE this year by considering if science and RE are complementary or conflicting. We will look at Genesis 1 and discuss the meaning of the creation story, whilst also considering different theological theories that some Christians use to interpret the creation story.

In Music this term, we will be looking at film music and the impact the music score can have on our enjoyment of the film. The children will be exploring and identifying the characteristics of film music before creating a composition and graphic score to perform alongside a film.
